As needed your pet will receive 24-hour care supervised by a veterinarian. Your pet will be separated from other pets and provided with a comfortable bed and individual attention. Dogs will be walked outside on a regular basis.

Surgical patients receive exceptional attention using the safest anesthetic techniques, fluid therapy, heat support, advanced patient monitoring, postoperative nursing care, and appropriate pain management.

After your pet's visit, you will receive clear instructions on follow-up care at home and when to have your pet rechecked. Your family veterinarian will receive a detailed faxed report. Updating you and your veterinarian is essential to high quality care for your pet. The PETSURG facility is conveniently located in Carmel Mountain Ranch just east of the 15 freeway in San Diego county. Our beautiful facility has 3 surgical suites, an accurate in-house laboratory, and state-of-the-art digital radiography equipment.

The PETSURG team offers surgery for soft tissue and orthopedic conditions.

Soft tissue surgery may include:

- Abdominal surgery: intestine, liver, kidney, spleen, bladder, diaphragm
- Thoracic surgery: lung lobe resection
- Cancer surgery: amputation, reconstruction, mandibulectomy
- Eye/ear surgery: ear canal ablation, bulla osteotomy
- Wound/reconstructive/plastic surgery: skin grafts, flaps
- Larynx/trachea/salivary surgery
- Genital surgery: perineal urethrostomy
- Brachycephalic surgeries: nostrils, palate, larynx, eyelids

Orthopedic procedures may include:

- Knee surgery: TPLO, TTA, MPL
- Hip surgery: FHNE, TPO
- Elbow surgery: luxation repair
- Fracture repair: Internal/external fixation
- Angular limb deformity correction
- Arthrodesis Carpal/Tarsal
- Special radiographic studies
