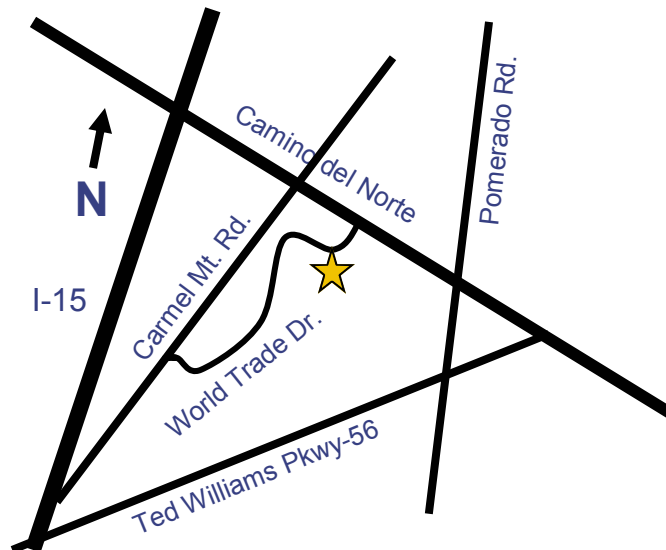


From Highway 78 Take I-15 South.

Communication with you and your veterinarian is essential to high quality care for your pet. Prior to procedures, we answer your questions, provide an estimate, ask for your consent, and help you understand how to make the decision that is best for you and your pet. Peace of mind is invaluable. PETSURG strives to relieve your stress regarding surgery and emergency treatment for your pet. Compassionate care is as critical as professional knowledge. The PETSURG team offers surgical and emergency services. Surgical services include soft tissue and orthopedic procedures. Soft tissue surgery means non-orthopedic procedures such as:

- abdominal or thoracic surgery
- cancer surgery
- ear surgery
- reconstructive or plastic surgery
- skin surgery

Orthopedic procedures include surgeries related to bone and joints such as knee or hip joint or a lameness evaluation.

Emergency services include treatment for urgent medical or surgical conditions, postoperative care, and monitoring of critical patients. For medical, surgical and emergency services, we offer rechecks on prior procedures and follow-up consultation.

The PETSURG facility is conveniently located in Carmel Mountain Ranch just east of the 15 freeway in San Diego county. We have 3 surgical suites, an accurate in-house laboratory, and state-of-the-art digital radiography equipment.
